Sunday 21 August

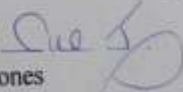

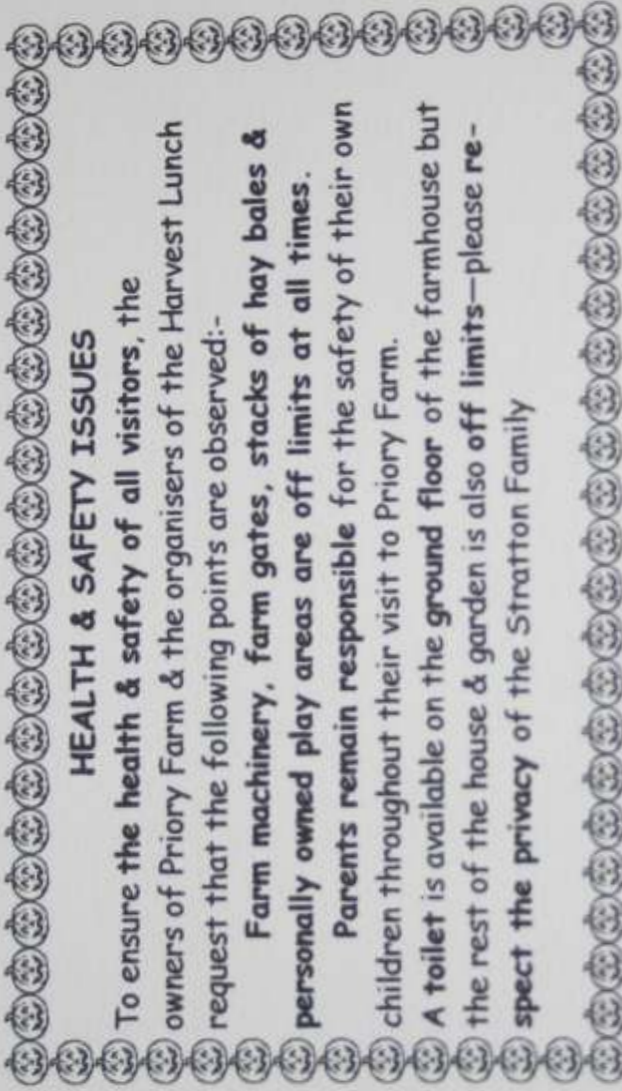
